

Procedure for Obtaining an Exhibition Vehicle Permit (EVP)

1. If a resident wishes to obtain a EVP they can print the application from the Borough website or contact the Borough Secretary for a hard copy.
2. Once the application is complete the resident must submit the application and a nonrefundable check or money order in the amount of \$25.00 per vehicle to the Borough Secretary.
 - a. No more than two (2) vehicles may be permitted in a 120-day period.
3. The applicant may either submit the application by mail or in person. All checks or money orders shall be made payable to Gratz Borough.
4. The application shall not be considered complete until all required information is completed on the application and all fees due are paid in full.
5. Provided the application meets the requirements of the Ordinance, the Borough Secretary will issue a permit, which is good for 120 calendar days from the date of issue. The approved permit will be mailed to the applicant or if convenient, picked up in person.
6. If the application is denied, the Borough Secretary will issue either a letter or email to the applicant explaining why the application was denied.
 - a. The applicant may then make corrections and resubmit the application.
 - b. No additional fee will be charged for resubmission of the application.
7. Once the Permit has been issued, the permit shall be posted on the property in a conspicuous place on which the work will be done and shall be protected from the elements. The permit placard shall be made readily available upon request by a Borough Official.
